



Head Office, Community Support & Social Facilities—Brighton

SDA's Head Office Operations including Community and Club Services will be based at Valley Social Centre in Whitehawk.

Valley Social Centre, Whitehawk Way, Whitehawk, Brighton, BN2 5HE is next to St Cuthmans Church. Entrance to Centre from St Cuthmans Close.



Where it is?

Buses - The 1 & 1A buses from Mile Oak, through Brighton City Centre, past Royal Sussex County Hospital into Whitehawk on a regular basis. The bus stops outside Valley Social Centre. Approx 20 minutes from City Centre.

By Car – Access into Brighton via A23/A27/A259 depending on direction you travel. Valley Social Centre have a car park situated off St Cuthmans Close (first come first served basis) but there is plenty of free on street parking available.

Train – No direct train service available. Plenty of buses running from Brighton Station to Western Road/North Street to change onto a Number 1 or 1A towards Whitehawk.

The Groups will be based on the **Ground Floor in the Function Room**. You have access to a hot water urn, unfortunately no oven for heating food available. Valley Social Centre can make food if booked at least 7 days in advance of event to cater for your large groups (Mon-Fri only **Not** Saturdays) if you have special events. They do have a café on the ground floor where you can pre-order and pay for drinks/food if needed between the hours of 9am-3pm Mon-Fri only. Cupboards for the clubs will be based in the function room.
